- 4. A report documenting the objective of the project alongside with simulation results, using EWB or PSPICE should be submitted and is worth 5 Points given to every student in the group.
- 5. An individual Oral test concludes the exam and is worth 5 points which will differ from a student to another.
- 6. A dead line will be announced, probably two weeks before the final second-term Exam.
